- It helps people with Hungarian roots to study in Hungary
- The Hungarian Diaspora Scholarship is a higher education scholarship programme
- Wide range of study programmes are available in 28 higher education institution
- The language of the study programmes: Hungarian or English
- Study mode: full-time, part-time
- **Study level**: bachelor's, master's, one-tier master's, doctoral, postgraduate specialist training courses and non-degree programmes (Hungarian preparatory courses)






ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

10 years of living outside Hungary

Recommendation

Age of 18 (minimum)

Last 4 years of secondary education in a foreign country



Benefits for scholarship holders



In the case of an active student status:

- a) education free of charge;
- b) in the first year of the studies: living allowance if requested in application (in the online application system)
 - a monthly scholarship of HUF 43,700 in bachelor's and master's programmes
 - the monthly scholarship for PhD scholarship holders is HUF 140,000 for the first two years, and HUF 180,000 per month in the second two years following the complex examination, PhD scholarship holders may apply for a one-off aid of HUF 400,000 considered as scholarship, subject to the award of a doctoral degree.
- c) dormitory accommodation OR HUF 40,000/month housing allowance, if requested in application
- d) NEW element: travel contribution if requested in application is a one-occasion travel allowance of HUF 330,000 between 8,000 and 19,999 km between Budapest and the city of the scholarship holder's place of residence



Benefits for scholarship holders



- e) healthcare, reimbursement of certified costs incurred (e.g., interpretation) in the case of supplementary or foreign-language healthcare services, or health insurance for up to 65,000 per year
- f) laboratory, library, computer, sport facilities provided by the host institution

Benefits are provided to one person. Does not provide visas, supplementary benefits or administrative services to the persons accompanying the scholarship holders or to their family members.

Visa administration and the extension of the residence permit is free of charge.



Felsőoktatási Ösztöndíjprogram Obligations for scholarship holders



Important obligations concerning learning Hungarian as a foreign language and culture

- 1. If studying on foreign language programmes scholarship holders are required to attend a Hungarian as a foreign language and culture course, failing to comply with this loss of scholarship status
- 2. Scholarship holders are required to take a language exam in Hungarian as a foreign language at least at an intermediate level before obtaining the degree, but not later than one year after obtaining the degree, failing to comply with this repayment of training costs.

Further important obligations

- 1. actively contribute to promoting, cultivating and preserving Hungarian language and culture in the diaspora community of any country after finishing their studies
- 2. establish a student status with the higher education institution involved
- 3. conclude an **agreement** with the host institution



Felsőoktatási Ösztöndíjprogram Obligations for scholarship holders



Further important obligations

- 4. The scholarship holder is required to **reside habitually in Hungary** during the training period
- 5. shall pursue and successfully complete their higher education studies to the best of their knowledge and ability
- 6. shall comply with their obligations of academic advancement set out in the studies and exams code and the curriculum by earning at least an average of 18 credits (appr. 60% of the amount of recommended credits/academic year) in each of the last two semesters in which their student status was not suspended
- 7. must participate in the **alumni** activities coordinated by the institution or the Public Foundation to the extent possible
- 8. actively **participate** in the events and programmes organised as part of the programme with the purpose of learning about Hungarian language and culture



Increase the number of Scholarship Holders



Travel contribution:

- upon request indicated in the online application system
- one-occasion travel allowance
- payment: within 30 days of the scholarship holder's enrollment; by a higher education institution
- Erasmus+ Distance Calculator

Non-eligibility criterium canceled:

permanent address in Hungary

Based on the distance between Budapest and the city of the destination:

8 000 - 19 999 km

HUF 330,000



New elements in the 2022/2023 application round



Postgraduate specialist training courses (1-2 years full-time, 1-2 semesters partial studies)

- **Not available:** extension; change of the study programme, institution and language; preparatory courses
- **Obligatory:** Hungarian as foreign language and culture course (in case of longer than 2 semesters courses, Scholarship Holders are required to pass a Hungarian as a foreign language exam at least at B2 level at the end of their studies but no later than within 1 year after obtaining the certificate)

Monthly stipend and dormitory/accommodation contribution from the second academic year of studies (upon request, the request will be examined upon academic achievement and financial situation, etc.)

Statement of the supervisor in doctoral studies: if required by the doctoral school, until 15th of March **Mandatory Medical Certificate:** must be submitted only by the applicants whose recommendation letter got evaluated and accepted by the Hungarian Diplomatic Representation, until 15th of April
